The school is a 58 x 28 building. When Richard left Uganda, the contractor was putting on the roof. The school should be finished by Thanksgiving. We will not be moving into the school until January 2008, as we have to make the school desks and gather the other miscellaneous items that go into furnishing the school. A member of the church is making the school desks and tables and if anyone would like to help with this we need around \$575.00 for easels, chairs, school desks, tables. The chalkboards are built in the walls; something that other schools in the area do not have.

The church will seat 200-225. Filling His Nets needs around \$375 for the seats inside the church. Because of the people of Poplar Spring Baptist Church in Murray, Kentucky, Filling His Nets Ministry will be able to continue the school and the church activities at Poplar Spring in Busowobi Village, Iganga, Uganda.

Other News:

We are in the last stages of registering Trace Creek Mission School. We are still in need of a 45 x 90 building to take care of P6 class. They are currently sitting outside in a tent because of no room. There are 52 students in this class.

We are not expanding Filling His Nets at this present time; we are in the process of accommodating all the progress and reviewing what is needed to sustain the growth that God has graciously given to His people.

USA News:

Thanks to all the people who have donated all clothing, furniture, and knick-knacks and etc. Heart To Hand has been an asset in the growth of the ministry in Uganda. We ask all pastors to inform their church members to bring any items that are not needed anymore to Heart To Hand. Heart To Hand is located in Mayfield at 518 Beech Street.
