WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING

We left for Uganda on June 5th and arrived safely. Much was accomplished while we were there.

Trace Creek Baptist School rafters and tin sheets are on. A problem occurred with the tin sheets. They were ordered by the hardware store but never were. Filling His Nets money was returned and new tin sheets were ordered from another hardware store and are now on the building. Plastering the walls and outside is going on now.

Baltimore Baptist Church gave money for Filling His Nets to dig a well. The well was dug and water hit on July 8th. We were not able to take pictures, but we left with Hellen Apuda a camera and she has taken pictures.

EMBRACING THE CHILDREN

We met a man in Kampala. He and his wife are from Texas. They have a children's home about 20 minutes from Kampala. There has been a problem with their stateside church and the church has had to forfeit their responsibility of the orphanage. Many of you know that one of my visions for Uganda was to have an orphanage. God is answering my prayers. The man and his wife are willing to come under Filling His Nets and move to Jinja. The only problem forthcoming is finding a place to house the orphans. So please be in prayer for housing that we can afford for these orphans. There are 26 children that need a good Christian background with people surrounding them with Christian love and nurturing.

US GRANT FOR FOOD

We received word from Gary Warren that the food arrived in Entebbe. We were able to pick up the food in Mukono District. We will need to monitor around 50 of the children in order for Legacy World Missions in Atlanta, Georgia to keep receiving grants for the children and orphanages of Uganda. What a blessing Pastor Gary has been to Filling His Nets and Richard and I.
